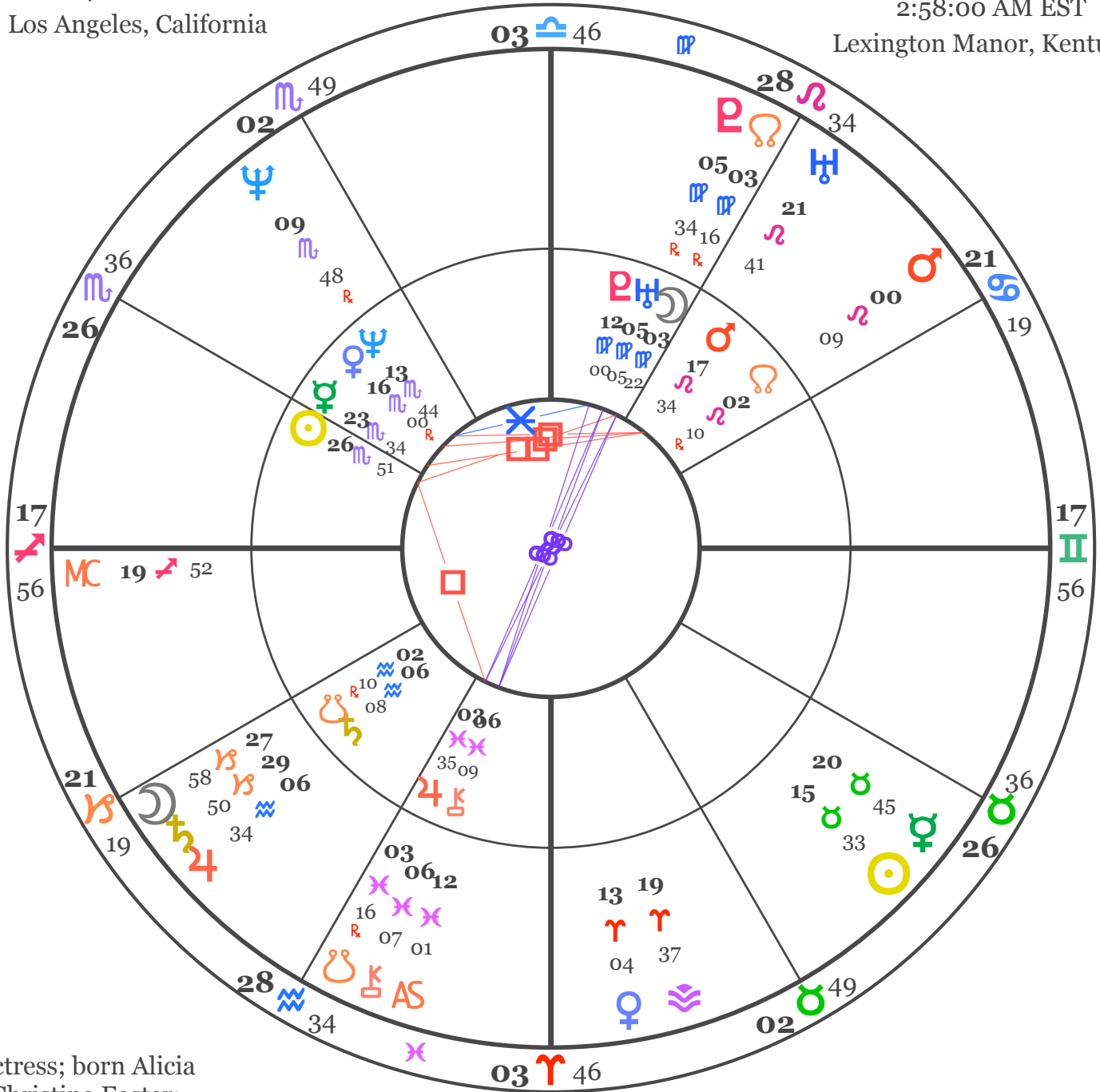

Part One -- Planets and Aspects

Each of us has every planet in his or her chart. Each planet symbolizes a different facet of life. In synastry, when we compare two charts, we look at the aspects (distance in degrees) between the planets of one chart and the planets of the other to determine areas of potential ease or difficulty. In general, sextiles and trines are easy aspects; squares and oppositions are challenging or dynamic aspects. Conjunctions can be either easy or difficult, depending on the planets involved.

Below, a brief (necessarily incomplete) description of the areas of life ruled by each of the planets: SUN: The life force, the ego center, who you are at your core. MOON: Feelings, home, mother, family, sensitivity, nurturing, moods. MERCURY: Communication, schooling, short trips, negotiations, the mind. VENUS: Emotions, aesthetic and artistic sense, what you have to offer a lover or partner if you're a woman; what you want in a partner if you're a man. MARS: Aggression, desires, competitiveness, ego drive, conflict, what you bring to a relationship if you're a man; what you want if you're a woman. JUPITER: Expansion, generosity, travel, optimism, knowledge, beliefs. SATURN: Restrictions, discipline, fear, burdens, status, ambition, authority. URANUS: Innovativeness, quirkiness, rebelliousness. NEPTUNE: Dreams, illusions, drugs, deception, spirituality. PLUTO: Death and regeneration, elimination, tumultuous change, power.

Common Aspects

Mercury opposite Mercury



This comparative aspect has both positive and negative potentials. Each of you is likely to cope with intellectual problems, thoughts and ideas from opposite ends of the spectrum. This can be quite beneficial and intellectually stimulating; it can also help promote cooperation and objectivity in your respective points of view, which can broaden your perspectives. However, you have to be willing to see the value in a point of view opposite your own in order to enjoy the positive potentials of this aspect. If either of you assumes automatically that yours is the only worthwhile perspective, this aspect is likely to produce clashes between you.

Neptune conjunct Neptune



Everyone born within a few years of each other has this aspect, making it more an indicator of generational relationships rather than personal relationships. It indicates a tendency to idealize the same institutions as others in your generation. People born into the generation when Neptune was in Libra, for instance, were likely to share the tendency to over-idealize marital relationships, or possibly use relationships as an escape, and are also likely to share similar feelings of disappointment and disillusionment when relationships offered less than perfect bliss. People born under Neptune in Capricorn may over idealize and escape into careers, traditions, etc.

Sun opposite Venus



Often an indication of romantic attraction, this aspect is considered especially potent if the Sun person is male and the Venus person female (the reverse is still plenty potent, however). This relationship may broaden your horizons as you introduce each other to art, entertainment, music and social activities that may in ways be opposite to what the other is used to, but pleasant nevertheless. There are a few potential negatives, although these are generally not particularly upsetting. The Sun person may occasionally feel that the Venus person is overly emotional; and the Venus person may sometimes view the Sun person as somewhat arrogant and domineering.

Sun square Mars



There is plenty of potential for clashes and competitiveness here as each of you feels your ego is on the line every time you have a disagreement. You must learn to channel your assertive tendencies into positive activities in order for the relationship to run smoothly. Agree to disagree, but don't take the other's position as a challenge to your own; just change the subject or the scenery and accept the other's right to an alternate point of view. If diplomacy doesn't work, don't let issues smolder between you. Air your points as clearly as possible, then kiss and make-up. (That's the upside of this square. You guys are probably great at kissing and making up.) You can also grow tremendously as individuals if you can learn to accept that -- even if you don't agree with it -- your partner's view is as valid for him or her as yours is for you.

Sun opposite Neptune



Because Neptune spends so many years in each sign, everyone born within a few years of each other will have Neptune in more or less the same position. This opposition is therefore more significant as an indication of the Sun person's response to an entire generation than as a trait in a one-to-one personal relationship. If the aspect is within a degree or so of exact, it can indicate that the Neptune person will either open up the Sun person's viewpoint to imaginative, charitable and, in some cases, spiritual possibilities or it can show that the two of you may clash over issues of idealism, romanticism and spirituality. There may also be a strong element of fantasy in the relationship if the aspect is very close.

Sun trine Pluto



As Pluto spends so many years in each sign, this trine is more significant as an indicator of the Sun person's response to an entire generation than as indication of one-to-one relationship traits. If the aspect is within a degree or so of exact, it can indicate an intense relationship with powerful positive feelings between you that can withstand problems and challenges and come back stronger each time. You probably also support each other's ambitions and help each other toward achievement and constructive change.

Mars conjunct North Node



You can support each other in work and other activities and make more of opportunities together than would be possible individually. The North Node person is likely to help the Mars person by slowing him or her down just enough so that he or she sees the best path to take more clearly than when racing furiously ahead without looking first. The Mars person can energize and inspire the North Node person to actualize plans and fulfill difficult but important goals.

Jupiter conjunct Saturn



You probably have a good, solid, cooperative relationship, which works especially well for you when you need to get things done together. The Saturn person can help the Jupiter person become more disciplined and turn ideals and ideas into something tangible and useful. The Jupiter person can help the Saturn person take a more positive view of the world and expand his or her horizons and self-esteem.

Sun sextile Moon



Understanding, supportive relationships are typical with this aspect. The Sun person can bolster the Moon person's moods when he or she is going through emotional ups and downs, and the Moon person is likely to be caring and sensitive toward the Sun person's ego needs and self-expressive urges. This aspect tends to smooth the way in domestic relationships. While the Sun person is generally dominant in relationships with this comparative aspect, he or she is unlikely to be domineering unless this trait is indicated by other chart factors.

Sun trine Mars



You are likely to be great cheerleaders and energizers for one another and should be able to get a great deal done together and individually as a result of the support you give one another. You can challenge each other in positive ways to achieve more. Often, this aspect is an indication of sexual attraction. You'll enjoy any kind of physical activity you engage in together, especially competitive sports and work that is physically challenging.

Sun sextile Saturn



You are likely to bring out the practical side in each other. This allows you to see the importance of the responsibilities you share and to take on the tasks related to those responsibilities with a sunny attitude. In fact, you can work quite well together on all sorts of cooperative ventures and achieve a great deal as a team. This aspect is favorable for any situation where responsibility and discipline are needed. You are also likely to feel a good deal of loyalty to, and protectiveness toward one another.

Moon conjunct Pluto



As Pluto takes many years to move through a sign, aspects to or from one person's Pluto to another's planets are not particularly significant in one-to-one relationships. This aspect instead shows how the Moon person responds to an entire

generation, including him or herself if a member of that generation. If the conjunction is very close (within one or two degrees) it can indicate a very intense relationship where each identifies with the other's emotions on a deep level. It can also be an indication of feelings of jealousy and emotional manipulation. Power struggles are also likely in a close conjunction. This is potentially a passionate combination but may be too tumultuous for warmth or comfort.

Moon conjunct North Node



This conjunction often indicates a compatibility between your emotional make-up and values. Both partners tend to provide support in the other's need to follow his or her life direction.

Mercury square Uranus



Stimulating mental jousting and exchanging of ideas are possible with this square between your charts, but these exchanges may sometimes unexpectedly lead to argument or misinterpretation. There may be a certain rashness in your communications; you speak first, think later. You may also bring out the tendency to radical thought in one another. If this square is close to exact, there can be a tendency to encourage each other in eccentric, impractical ideas.

Jupiter opposite Pluto



Because Pluto spends so many years in each sign, everyone born within a few years of each other will have Pluto in more or less the same position. This opposition is therefore more significant as an indication of the Jupiter person's response to an entire generation than as a trait in a one-to-one personal relationship. If the aspect is within a degree or so of exact, it can indicate that one or the other of you may use manipulation or propagandist techniques in an attempt to gain an advantage from the other.

Jupiter conjunct South Node



There's a slight potential for one of you (usually the Jupiter person) to be a bit overbearing toward the other with this conjunction, with the attitude of "I know what's best for you." While this may at times be true, it can ruffle the other's feathers and cause him or her to do the exact opposite of what you hope. There is also a slight danger that the pair of you will adopt a you-and-me-against-the-world attitude, which can become a self-fulfilling prophesy.

Uranus conjunct Pluto



As this is a conjunction of two slow moving planets, each of which will occupy a single sign for many years, this aspect is more significant for showing how generations relate to each other than as an indicator of personal relationship traits. It can indicate shared generational concerns regarding social change or revolutionary ideas.

Uranus conjunct North Node



With this aspect, the two of you are likely to flout social convention and go your

own eccentric way together. Otherwise, this is not a particularly potent influence in the comparative chart.

Pluto opposite Ascendant

  AS

This comparative aspect intensifies the passion between two people, but it also intensifies jealousy, secretiveness, scheming, manipulation and struggles for control. There's nothing superficial about a relationship with this aspect, especially if it's close to exact, but there may be plenty that is hidden beneath the surface. There may be almost continual upheaval at certain stages of this relationship. But, if you ride it out and the relationship survives, it can come back stronger and better each time -- and you can grow as a result, both as a couple and as individuals.

Ascendant conjunct Midheaven

AS  MC

The Ascendant person can identify with what the Midheaven person is trying to achieve and the Midheaven person should be able to identify with the way the Ascendant person relates to the world. Often though, this understanding can be a reason for you two to feel competitive toward each other, unless other aspects soften this response.

Part Two -- Planets in Houses

This section is concerned with where the planets of one partner fall in the houses of the other, also known as comparative house placement. For instance, if you have 12 degrees Cancer rising (also known as Cancer Ascendant or Cancer on the first house cusp) and your partner has Moon in 15 degrees Cancer, your partner's Moon falls in your first house. Your experience of your partner's emotions, family and moods (Moon) will influence how you see yourself (Ascendant). In comparative house placement analysis, the planets generally have a greater impact on the houses than the houses do on the planets. In other words, where your partner's planets fall in your houses is a better indication of how you experience him or her than vice-versa. And where your planets fall in his or her houses will tell more about how he or she experiences you.

HOUSE SIX

The morning after the partying of the fifth house, you've got to get back down to business, and that's what the sixth house is about. It rules work, health, service, worries, diet, dress, personal habits and other mundane, but necessary details of life. When someone else's planets fall into your sixth house, the energies of those planets will affect the way you respond to the above sixth house issues. If, for instance, someone's Saturn is in your sixth house, he or she might be an authority (Saturn rules authority figures) who you consult about health, such as a doctor; or he or she might be your boss at work.

Moon in House 6

 in 6th

This comparative placement often occurs when a relationship centers around a workplace, health club, medical office; any place or in any situation where a service

is rendered. The moods of the Moon person can have an impact on the sixth house person's sense of well-being. The rules and methods of the sixth house person can affect the emotions of the Moon person. There may be problems arising from a difference in approach to neatness, hygiene or organization.

Mars in House 6

♂ in 6th

This placement can be a double-edged sword. At best, the Mars person can stimulate the sixth house person to a healthier lifestyle; at worst, he or she can cause aggravation that may lead to health problems or accidents. The Mars person can energize the sixth house person to take a more aggressive, active stance in work situations, and may challenge the sixth house person's attitudes toward diet, health, fitness and/or fashion.

Uranus in House 6

♅ in 6th

The Uranus person is likely to have a surprising effect on the sixth house person's work situation, health habits or dress. The Uranus person may introduce the sixth house person to different attitudes concerning diet, work or fitness.

Pluto in House 6

♇ in 6th

The Pluto person can have a regenerative or restorative impact on the sixth house person's work situation, diet, health routines or dress. This usually requires supporting aspects between Pluto and the sixth house person's planets if it is to have more than just a subtle effect.

HOUSE EIGHT

The eighth house deals with a host of intense and weighty issues: death, obsessions, repression, jealousy, taxes, joint resources, inheritances and other people's possessions. It also represents what you want or need sexually. When someone else's planets fall in your eighth house, the energies of those planets will have an impact on how you think, feel and act concerning eighth house issues. If, for instance, your rich old Great-Uncle Harry's Jupiter falls in your eighth house, he might bequeath you a generous inheritance in his will.

Mercury in House 8

☿ in 8th

With Mercury here, there is the possibility that you will be overly critical of one another concerning the handling of joint resources, taxes, insurance and inheritances. The Mercury person can stimulate the eighth house person to think and talk about deep and profound issues. The eighth house person's resources can affect Mercury person's ideas and discussions.

Venus in House 8

♀ in 8th

This can be an indication of intense romantic attraction, but it may be tinged with jealousy, secretiveness or desire for material gain. The Venus person can have a beneficial effect on your joint resources as a partner or may enjoy an improved financial situation as a result of the association. You can benefit as a couple through matters relating to taxes, insurance, inheritance and investments.

Neptune in House 8

♆ in 8th

This can indicate a deep relationship where you each have an intuitive understanding of what the other is feeling, but it can also indicate mind games and psychological confusion. There is a slight potential for financial loss through unwise or unrealistic joint financial dealings or business ventures. Occasionally, this can indicate a relationship that is caring and loving in many respects, but non-sexual.

HOUSE NINE

The ninth house is directly opposite the third in your chart and represents a higher order of some of the issues governed by the third house. Foreign travel or other long trips, higher learning, philosophy, culture, religion, law and book publishing are all matters related to this house. When the planets of another person fall into your ninth house, the energies of those planets can affect how you respond to ninth house issues. For instance, if a friend's Uranus, the planet of innovation and surprises, falls in your ninth, he or she might introduce you to a new philosophical system or a new way of thinking about situations or events; or he/she might be the perfect traveling companion for an adventurous trip.

Sun in House 9

☉ in 9th

The Sun person can have a rousing effect on the ninth house person's sense of adventure and need to explore -- either intellectually or actively. The Sun person's philosophy, beliefs and knowledge are likely to have an impact on the way the ninth house person views the world. You can spur each other to greater ideas, and can cover a lot of territory, mentally and physically, through association with each other.

HOUSE ELEVEN

Friends, acquaintances, associates, associations, clubs, and virtually any other group you feel a part of are all matters related to the eleventh house. This is also the house governing your hopes, wishes and professional values (personal values are matters of the second house). When someone else's planets fall here in your chart, the energies of those planets will affect your reactions to eleventh house issues. For instance, if a friend's Pluto, the planet of power, falls in your eleventh, your association with that person can potentially bring you greater power and control.

Saturn in House 11

♄ in 11th

The Saturn person can help the eleventh house person to work with discipline and care toward realizing practical goals. The Saturn person can also provide networking opportunities which can further the eleventh house person's ambitions. There is the possibility that you will both feel part of a larger group that works toward some serious purpose. There is a slight potential that one of you may have entered into this relationship with ulterior motives, but only if other factors, such as major harsh aspects from Saturn to planets in the eleventh house, support this. Hard aspects from Saturn also sometimes indicate that the Saturn person, intentionally or unintentionally, may limit the eleventh house person's interactions with friends and associates.

HOUSE TWELVE

This is the house of illusion, where things are not quite what they seem. Secrets, ideals, deception and self-deception, dreams, drugs, chronic illness, institutions and intuition are all matters of the twelfth house. Older astrology texts call this the house of self-undoing, but this is probably too negative a reading in most cases. It is true, though, that it is difficult to get a clear picture of what is going on in this house; so the energies of any planets of another person that fall into your twelfth are likely to be harder for you to understand than those falling in other houses. If, for instance, someone's Venus falls in your twelfth, you may find it difficult to see that person's flaws and you may respond to the person as if he or she were your ideal mate, whether or not this is objectively realistic.

Jupiter in House 12

♃ in 12th

This is likely to be a highly idealistic relationship with a beneficial impact on each of you that may not be apparent to those outside the relationship. You will work best together when you allow your natural desire to give of yourselves to be expressed. You tend to bring out the empathic, charitable and caring sides in each other and may opt to work together on altruistic projects. You may also bring out the spiritual side in each other.

HOUSE TWO

This is the house of what you have, both in a tangible and intangible sense. It rules your possessions, your values and what you have to give sexually to your partner. When the planets of another person fall into this house, you are likely to experience the energies symbolized by those planets as having an impact on your sense of self-worth, your possessions, your material security or your personal value system.

Moon in House 2

☾ in 2nd

With this placement, the Moon person's emotional security may depend on the financial security or material worth of the second house person. The Moon person's feelings can have an effect on what the second house person values, both in a tangible and intangible way. You may try to shore up your sense of worth by accumulating material possessions, or you may become too emotionally attached to the possessions you collect together.

Jupiter in House 2

♃ in 2nd

The Jupiter person can have a positive effect on the second house person's financial situation and ability to amass material goods, but may also influence second house person to be wasteful or extravagant. This extravagance is especially evident when there are harsh major aspects from Jupiter to the second house person's planets. If there are major favorable aspects however, the Jupiter person can be something of a financial good luck charm for the second house person.

Saturn in House 2

♄ in 2nd

The Saturn person can help the second house person be more serious and responsible regarding all manner of tangible and intangible values. This influence extends not only to financial and business matters, but to personal ethics and principles as well. Occasionally, this placement indicates that the second house person's resources may be limited, or financial losses may be incurred, as a result of association with the Saturn person. This is generally true only if Saturn makes harsh major aspects to the second house person's planets or if other major chart factors support this.

HOUSE FOUR

The fourth house rules the home, real estate, your mother (and your mothering instincts), as well as home, domestic and family situations in general. It is also the house ruling your final resting place. Those whose planets fall in your fourth house will affect you on a deep level, and may arouse your protective and nurturing instincts. If the Sun, Moon, Venus, Jupiter or Ascendant of another falls in your fourth house, you may make good housemates or domestic partners.

Venus in House 4

♀ in 4th

This placement can be an indication of deep emotional empathy between you. It is very favorable for those who share a home together. The Venus person can have a soothing effect on the fourth house person's feelings. The fourth house person can make the Venus person feel cared for and at ease. You tend to enjoy home-based activities together and focus on creating a pleasant domestic environment. The Venus person is likely to beautify the fourth house person's domestic scene.

HOUSE FIVE

Some astrologers refer to the fifth as the party house, and it's an apt description. The fifth house presides over entertainment and fun of all kinds; including romance, gambling, parties, creativity and pleasure in general. It is also the house of children, and may describe certain traits of your first child. When the planets of another fall into your fifth house, the energies of these planets will have an affect on what you do, think and feel about fifth house issues. If someone's Sun falls into your fifth house, for instance, you may be attracted to that person as a romantic partner or as someone to simply go out and have good times with.

Sun in House 5

☉ in 5th

The fifth is generally considered the "party" house, so with this placement, you are likely to enjoy each other's company, especially when sharing pleasurable activities together. This combination is favorable for people who want to have children together, but equally favorable for those who simply like to go out to the movies, a concert or a restaurant with each other and have a good time. The Sun person can stimulate the fifth house person's creativity and gregariousness and will know how to make him or her laugh and smile. If either of you is particularly attractive, your partner will probably enjoy showing you off on his or her arm.

Mercury in House 5

♀ in 5th

There is likely to be much discussion between you about the relationship itself. The Mercury person's ideas tend to affect the way the fifth house person views entertainment, romance, children and fun times in general. The creative impulses of the fifth house person are likely to stimulate the thoughts and communication of the Mercury person.

HOUSE EIGHT

The eighth house deals with a host of intense and weighty issues: death, obsessions, repression, jealousy, taxes, joint resources, inheritances and other people's possessions. It also represents what you want or need sexually. When someone else's planets fall in your eighth house, the energies of those planets will have an impact on how you think, feel and act concerning eighth house issues. If, for instance, your rich old Great-Uncle Harry's Jupiter falls in your eighth house, he might bequeath you a generous inheritance in his will.

Mars in House 8

♂ in 8th

This tends to indicate a passionate relationship, but often with elements of secrecy, selfishness, jealousy and intrigue. You may put joint resources at risk in foolish or poorly thought out expenditures and investments. There may be an element of danger to this relationship and, in rare cases, if supported by at least two other strong indicators, there may even be physical confrontations between the two of you. If there are harsh major aspects from Mars to the eighth house person's chart, the Mars person may at times treat joint resources as his or her exclusive property, without regard for the eighth house person's needs or wishes.

Uranus in House 8

♅ in 8th

This often indicates a potential for sudden changes in fortune, for better or worse, in your joint resources and holdings. Often, it's an indication of something untraditional, unconventional or eccentric in matters of sex. You may have secret mutual kinks or quirks. You can be powerful agents of change in each other's lives.

HOUSE NINE

The ninth house is directly opposite the third in your chart and represents a higher order of some of the issues governed by the third house. Foreign travel or other long trips, higher learning, philosophy, culture, religion, law and book publishing are all matters related to this house. When the planets of another person fall into your ninth house, the energies of those planets can affect how you respond to ninth house issues. For instance, if a friend's Uranus, the planet of innovation and surprises, falls in your ninth, he or she might introduce you to a new philosophical system or a new way of thinking about situations or events; or he/she might be the perfect traveling companion for an adventurous trip.

Pluto in House 9

♇ in 9th

The Pluto person can have a subtle transformative effect on the beliefs and ideals of the ninth house person, but this usually requires aspects from Pluto to the ninth house person's personal planets for the potentials to be fully activated.

HOUSE ELEVEN

Friends, acquaintances, associates, associations, clubs, and virtually any other group you feel a part of are all matters related to the eleventh house. This is also the house governing your hopes, wishes and professional values (personal values are matters of the second house). When someone else's planets fall here in your chart, the energies of those planets will affect your reactions to eleventh house issues. For instance, if a friend's Pluto, the planet of power, falls in your eleventh, your association with that person can potentially bring you greater power and control.

Neptune in House 11

♃ in 11th

It's likely that this relationship has a basis in friendship and idealism. This combination is favorable for relationships where the partners are involved in groups or organizations with humanitarian, spiritual or socially uplifting goals . You may feel that this is a dream-come-true kind of relationship. However there is the potential for disillusionment if you refuse to see each other as you really are, warts and all.
